## ATTENTION\*\*\*ATTENTION HOLIDAY DECORATIONS

The Association rules state that no changes are allowed to be made to change the outward appearance of a building, and that nothing is to be attached to a building (overhang, shingles and walls). However, the Association respects the desire of residents wishing to decorate the exterior of their unit in order to celebrate holidays. Holiday decorations will be permitted with limitations to ensure that costly damage does not occur, or that warrantees for exterior building components are not in jeopardy of being made void. –Please abide by the following guidelines or you will be required to remove the decorations and will be financially responsible for any damage.

- The balcony and railing may be used for this purpose. Any fastener that is used cannot penetrate the metal railing and must be removed with the decorations.
- Decorations and/or lights may be installed both on the interior and exterior side of the fence, and on bushes which have direct contact with the exterior of your fence.
  - Use only fasteners which will not damage the fence or bushes.
  - Ensure that you do not to step on the irrigation equipment which is above ground and behind the bushes.
  - Electrical cords must be protected and properly rated for outside use and cannot create any fire or trip hazards.

Middlebrook Pines Board of Directors will have final say as a whether installed decorations are acceptable.  Recorations must be removed within two (2) weeks following the end of the holiday season.
