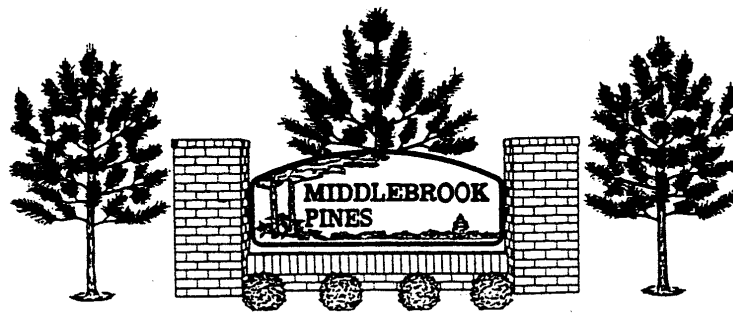

HOLIDAY/SEASONAL DECORATIONS REGULATIONS

The Association rules state that no changes are permitted to be made which will change the outward appearance of a building, and that nothing is to be attached to a building (overhang, shingles, and walls). However, the Association respects the desire of residents wishing to decorate the exterior of their unit to celebrate holidays. Decorations will be permitted for specific periods of time, with limitations, to ensure that costly damage does not occur, and warranties are not voided. Decorations should be in good taste and fit with the holiday/season. The Board of Directors have the final say as to what is considered appropriate. Please abide by the following guidelines or you will be required to remove the decorations and will be financially responsible for any damage.

HOLIDAY/SEASONAL CALENDAR – DECORATION TIMEFRAME

- **Easter** – Weekend before holiday to the Saturday after
- **Independence Day (July 4th)** – Saturday before the holiday to Saturday after
- **Halloween (October 31st)** – October 1 to Saturday after the holiday
- **Thanksgiving**– Saturday before the holiday to Saturday after
- **Winter Holidays** - Saturday before Thanksgiving to January 10th

RULES TO FOLLOW

- The balcony and railing may be used for this purpose. Any fastener that is used cannot penetrate or damage the metal railing or paint and must be removed with the decorations.
- Large decorations or inflatables ARE NOT permitted on balconies due to possible abrasion damage to the building.
- Patio trees and shrubs may be used for this purpose, but decoration cannot extend beyond the fence.
- Decorations and/or lights may be installed on the interior side and top of the fence and may hang over and onto the fence exterior if installed from the inside of the patio to avoid walking between the bushes. Decorations CANNOT extend to the bushes, or anywhere in the common areas. Decorations are permitted on the gate exterior only during the approved dates.–
 - Use only fasteners which will not damage the wooden fence.
 - Electrical cords must be protected and properly rated for outside use.

CORRECTIONS REQUIRED

Please immediately remove any items checked or notated below.

- Decorations and/or lighting cannot be attached to the building exterior wall.
- Decorations and/or lighting cannot be attached to the shingles/siding or the overhangs.
- Decorations and/or lighting are not permitted in bushes or common areas.
- Inflatables or large decorations are not permitted on balconies or within 2 feet of a building.
- Decorations are not appropriate and should be removed.

If not corrected in one (1) week, the association will arrange to remove and dispose of them at owner's expense.
